

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




Reduced the Number of Classes/Units Because of Hours Working



Factors that Impacted Ability to Take or Finish a Class
















Expenses Paid with Financial Aid or Job Income









Modes of Transportation to Get to School and Work












Frequency Being Late to Class or Work Due to Commute




Average Commuting Distance Between School, Work, and Home Average Number of Days


Primary Factor that Influences Type of Internship Wanted




